- Furniture*
- Home decor, linens
- Automobiles
- CD's, DVD's, records, tapes
- Infant cribs, strollers/carriages, playpens, car seats
- Exercise equipment

- Household dishes, cookware
- Electrical (e.g. radios, clocks, lamps, iron)
- Non-perishable food items, paper products, personal hygiene items
- Small & large household appliances: stoves, refrigerators, washers, dryers, toasters, microwaves, coffee makers

ITEMS WE <u>CAN'T ACCEPT</u>

It's hard to say "no thank you" to a donation. However, there are some items we cannot accept.

- Household items such as air conditioners, water heaters, mattresses and box springs
- Building materials: carpet, shutters, doors, windows, toilets, lumber, concrete, bricks
- Televisions, computers, printers, monitors, peripherals
- Antiques, collectibles and jewelry
- Automobile parts: tires, wheels, batteries, seats, body parts and engines
- Paint or chemicals. Greater Vision is not allowed to dispose of these items in a landfill
- Kerosene & gas heaters/appliances. Greater
 Vision is not licensed to handle these items
- Any CPSC recalls or other recalled items or items containing lead/phthalates
