- Social security cards for all family members
- Proof of all household income
- Letter from DSS (if applicable)
- Vouchers from referral agencies (if applicable)

DO YOU QUALIFY FOR SERVICES?

- Must be employed or employable, having worked a job within 6 months of applying for services.
- Must have dependents living in your home. These dependents may include children under 18, disabled adult children or disabled parents.
- Total income must fall below the Self-Sufficiency Standards* for their county.

*Your client advisor will help you determine what your self-sufficiency amount is and can help you set goals to meet that standard.



WHAT ARE YOUR NEXT STEPS?

Greater Vision wants to help you maximize your current resources and build new ones to achieve your goals on your path to self-sufficiency. If you are ready for a fresh start, here are your next steps:

- **Step 1: Call to make an appointment**
Call 252.527.4401 to speak with a client advisor who will share more about the program and help determine if you qualify for services.
- **Step 2: Apply to the program**
Once it is determined you qualify for services, you can then apply to the program and set up a time to meet with your client advisor to begin setting goals.
- **Step 3: Work the program**
You and your client advisor will set goals and develop a step-by-step action plan to help your family reach self-sufficiency.
- **Step 4: Graduate the program**
You achieved your goals and are self-sufficient!
