1. **Promote.** Food Roundup flyers (see enclosed sheet), ads, slides and other downloadable resources are available. Use them in your printed and email newsletters. Post flyers in your church. Share the Food Roundup on social media! Find them at www.bchfoodroundup.org

2. **Encourage your members.** Publicize the needs list in your church (See enclosed sheet.) **Please note: Due to licensure regulations, we cannot use outdated food. Check expiration dates and buy food that has the longest shelf life.**

3. **Find out where to deliver your collections.** A collection point is designated for your area. Contact your associational office to find out where to take the items your church has collected. Collection points will also be publicized in the April edition of *Charity & Children* and on the BCH website at www.bchfoodroundup.org. **Food pick up from collection points begins Monday, April 23. You will need to find out the last day your collection point will accept food deliveries prior to the April 23 starting date.**



4. **Who do you know?** You may have a connection with a distributor who would be willing to donate items from the needs list. If so, please reach out to them or send their contact information to **Alan Williams at 1.800.476.3669, ext. 1277 or awilliams@bchfamily.org**

5. **Rally volunteers in your church.** Recruit missions, youth and other volunteer groups to help at association offices and collection points to box and load items onto delivery vehicles. Call their contact person for details (a list will be in the April edition of *Charity & Children*).



6. **Box it up.** Sort and place the food/supplies in sturdy boxes for loading and transport.

7. **We need volunteers.** Need a missions project in May, June or July? Please volunteer to help process and inventory the food and supplies at BCH locations. Call a BCH location near you, or contact **Alan Williams at 1.800.476.3669, ext. 1277 or awilliams@bchfamily.org**

8. **Trucks and drivers needed.** We are in need of large trucks to help with pickup. If you know of someone who has access to a truck that might be able to help with pickup and/or delivery, contact **Alan Williams at 1.800.476.3669, ext. 1277 or awilliams@bchfamily.org**
