Baptist Children's Homes (BCH) provides compassionate services for children and families in southeastern North Carolina at **Odum Home in Pembroke**. Dedicated staff members work tirelessly to meet the needs of children in care. Like all BCH locations, Odum Home places a high value on helping meet spiritual needs by providing church services, vespers, and cottage devotions. Odum Home is located a cross from The University of North Carolina at Pembroke. Odum Home offers cottage homes, after care, and family care services.



Odum Home, once known as the Indian Orphanage, is a part of BCH's statewide family. Pembroke is known as the "Land of the Lumbee" and Odum Home maintains its connection to the rich traditions of the community. Odum Home serves a tri-racial composition serving BCH's mission of "sharing hope...changing lives."

Model of Care: Baptist Children's Homes uses the CARE Model developed by Cornell University. Children And Residential Experiences (CARE): Creating Conditions for Change is designed to support safe environments, strong programmatic elements and a wide-variety of treatment programs and interventions that are trauma-sensitive and developmentally appropriate. It is designed with the child's best interests in mind.

CARE is based on the following six principles:

- 1) Developmentally focused, 2) Family involved, 3) Relationship based, 4) Competence centered, 5) Trauma informed, 6) Ecologically oriented.

Caring Homes for Children: Odum Home provides cottage homes where professionally-trained child care workers (cottage parents) care for children in a Christian, family environment. Case managers work with family members, as appropriate, to help them identify and overcome their challenges. **After care** is provided to child and custodian following each residential service placement. **Transitional Living** helps older children learn the skills they need to live as independent adults once leaving Odum Home's care

Service Area: Odum Home serves the following North Carolina counties: Anson, Bladen, Brunswick, Columbus, Cumberland, Harnett, Hoke, Richmond, Robeson, Sampson, Scotland. Other counties will be considered based upon need.

Cost of Services

Cost of service is based on a sliding fee scale for parent or relative custodians. DSS custodians will pay based on a pre-established purchase of service charge.
